I. MAYOR'S STATEMENT

Mayor Brasses stated CDBG funds are to be made available through the Home Improvement Program at St. Louis County to qualified residents until September 1, 2020, and if funds have not been committed by that date, they will be applied to ADA projects.

II. CDBG FUNDS THROUGH THE HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Alderman Maurath explained that \$20,000 dollars each year is offered to be used for home improvements through St. Louis County and they use a third-party so no one knows who qualified or what their finances are. Leftover funds go to City ADA improvements. Alderman Sobey said it was a win-win situation since either someone from City benefits or ADA projects are funded.
