**FENTON, MISSOURI – Tuesday, March 1, 2016** – During the December 2015 flooding, Fenton City Park (1215 Larkin Williams Rd.) was greatly affected and received substantial damage to fields, shelters, restrooms and more.

At this time, Fenton Parks and Recreation is not issuing field or shelter rentals in Fenton City Park until after April 15, 2016, (date subject to change). If you are a City of Fenton Resident, shelter rentals at other Fenton parks are available. Please call RiverChase at 636-343-0067 to check availability.

We have been informed by St. Louis County that all underground wiring at Fenton City Park will require replacement. This requirement change will significantly impact the total restoration of all services. The City of Fenton and outside crews are working hard to repair electrical and structural damage throughout Fenton City Park.

We appreciate your patience during this time and will continue to update the public on the status of Fenton City Park as often as we can.
