Notice is hereby given that the City of Fenton Board of Aldermen will hold a Public Hearing to discuss the estimated allocation of \$20,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds which will become available after January 1, 2023. The Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, September 22, 2022, 6:45 p.m. at Fenton City Hall, 625 New Smizer Mill Road, Fenton, Missouri.
