AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FLOCK GROUP, INC. TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE LICENSE PLATE READERS WITHIN THE CITY FOR ANOTHER TERM OF ONE YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen via Ordinance 4083 authorized execution of an agreement with Flock Group, Inc. to participate in a 60-day pilot program for installation of license plate readers within the City (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, during such trial period, the City was able to install ten (10) Flock Safety cameras within the City and learn how to utilize the Flock ALPR system; and

WHEREAS, due to the success of the pilot program, via Ordinance 4108, the Board of Aldermen approved a first amendment to the Agreement to extend the use of the cameras for an additional one (1) year after expiration of the pilot period; and

WHEREAS, during the February 3rd, 2022 Committee Meeting, the Board of Aldermen reviewed some of the successful results from utilization of the Flock ALPR system and discussed renewing the Agreement for another one (1) year term at the same cost and under the same terms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds it in the public interest and desires to authorize an extension and amendment to the Agreement to authorize another one (1) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute on behalf of the City a second amendment to the Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. for the utilization of the ten (10) Flock Safety cameras to extend the term an additional one (1) year at a cost not to exceed of \$25,000.00, in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.

**The Second Amendment to the
Flock Group Inc. Agreement**

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen via Ordinance 4083 authorized execution of an agreement with Flock Group, Inc. to participate in a 60-day pilot program for installation of license plate readers within the City (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, during such trial period, the City was able to install ten (10) Flock Safety cameras within the City and learn how to utilize the Flock ALPR system; and

WHEREAS, due to the success of the pilot program, via Ordinance 4108, the Board of Aldermen approved a first amendment to the Agreement (“the First Amendment”) to extend the use of the cameras for an additional one (1) year after expiration of the pilot period; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to authorize an extension and amendment to the Agreement to authorize another one (1) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and agreements herein set forth and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement shall continue for one (1) additional year that expires on March 31, 2023.
2. The parties hereby reaffirm that all other provisions of the Agreement and First Amendment not specifically amended herein, including the fee of \$25,000 for ten (10) cameras, shall remain in full force and effect through the term extension and shall be deemed incorporated herein and binding on the parties.
3. The Agreement and First Amendment together with this amendment represents the entire agreement among the parties and Flock Group Inc. agrees that it has not relied on any representations or warranties of the City, oral or written, other than expressly identified in this amendment.
