AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 4, 2023, IN THE CITY OF FENTON, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI WITH CANDIDATE FILING TO OPEN DECEMBER 6, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The annual general election for the City of Fenton, Missouri is hereby called and shall be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2023.

Section 2. There shall be elected a Mayor for a two-year term, four Aldermen, one each from the City's four Wards for two year-terms, and one alderman from Ward 2 for a one-year term.

Section 3. Candidate filing will open on Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. and will close on Tuesday, December 27, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. Forms for filing will be provided by the City of Fenton, Office of the City Clerk, 625 New Smizer Mill Road, pursuant to Section 115.030 of the Fenton Municipal Code.

Section 4. The polling places for such election shall be designated by the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County, Missouri.

Section 5. The polls shall be open for this election from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Section 6. Upon approval of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall cause a Notice of the Election in the manner provided by Section 115.050 of the Fenton Municipal Code and is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as are necessary to provide for such election.

Section 7. If any clause, word, paragraph, section, or other part or portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional for any reason, the Board of Aldermen hereby declares it would nevertheless have enacted the remaining portions thereof and such remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
