AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MUSCO SPORTS LIGHTING, LLC FOR FENTON CITY PARK SOCCER FIELD LIGHTING.

WHEREAS, during the Board of Aldermen Committee Meeting on February 9, 2023, the Director of Public Works presented a quote from Musco Sports Lighting, LLC (“Musco”) for the installation of field lighting within Fenton City Park to provide the Board an idea as to the cost for the purchase and installation of soccer field lighting; and

WHEREAS, the quote from Musco was obtained from the cooperative Sourcewell so the price obtained was competitively bid for the City; and

WHEREAS, the quote is for lighting two soccer fields and an option to provide wire conduit for future lighting of a third field (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, after discussion by the Board, a motion was made to forward a contract with Musco in accordance with the quote for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Staff worked with Musco and Musco agreed to execute the City’s form contract, including submitting payment and performance and maintenance bonds, opposed to the Sourcewell cooperative contract at the same pricing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to and finds it in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with Musco for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby finds its bidding procedures were complied with and authorizes the Mayor to execute on behalf of the City a contract with Musco for the Project in substantially in the form of Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the “Contract”).

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Section 2. The requirements of Section 292.675 RSMo. and the OSHA requirements and obligations and penalties in the Contract are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

Section 3. The requirements of Section 290.210 RSMo., and the prevailing wage requirements and obligations in the Contract, including without limitation the specific prevailing wages (including the rate for holiday and overtime work) and the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations' determination of the prevailing wages, are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes. Additionally, a copy of Annual Wage Order for St. Louis County No. 29, being the applicable prevailing wage order for the Project, is part of the Contract Documents and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the date of its passage and approval.
