Each household is allowed FIVE (5) bulk items, 75-pound weight limit per item. **All items must be from that residence, and MUST be placed at the curb by 7:00 am.** Any items not picked up will be the responsibility of that resident to dispose of.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Wooden Furniture
- Headboards
- Lamps
- Sinks
- Construction Debris (limit 1 - 50 lb. can)
- Lumber shorter than 4 ft. (no complete decking)
- Wooden Bed Frames
- Box Springs
- Chairs
- Fans
- General Refuse from Clean-up
- Mattresses
- Sofas/Love Seats/Commodes
- Rugs
- Linoleum (rolled or bundled)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Tree Branches/Stumps
- Concrete
- Yard Debris
- Rocks/Dirt/Concrete
- Recyclables
- Paint/Hazardous Waste*
- Car Parts/Tires
- Electronics
- Lumber longer than 4 ft.

* *Hazardous Waste Includes: Paint, Pesticides, Herbicides, Gas, and Oil*
