- ***\$10 Fee – One TV per household/vehicle*** (Note: TV's that are "Gutted" or have exposed or shattered glass cannot be accepted), VCR's, stereos, audio and video equipment including cable and satellite boxes
- *Lawn equipment, tools, old mowers, tillers (**gas & oil must be removed**)*
- *All appliances—from Blenders to Dishwashers, to Washers & Dryers and Commercial Refrigerator's***
- *Batteries, Wires, AC Adapters, Cables, etc.*
- *Medical, Surgical, Dental, and Vet Equipment (No bio hazardous items please!)*
- *Any and all metal containing items with at 50% metal content*
- ***There is a \$10 fee for each CRT "TUBE" TV – The proper recycling of CRT televisions is very expensive and we ask that this policy be respected.**
- ****RNA WorldWide is HVAC Certified by the EPA for the proper handling of refrigerant.**
